Our Class

Author:

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Music As musicians, the children will be building on their skills of playing the recorder, learning new notes. They will also learn to sing *Living on a Prayer* by Bon Jovi. They will combine this knowledge to attempt a musical rendition of the song.



English

As readers, the children will be reading an adapted version of Shakespeare's *Macbeth*. They will be exploring the settings and different characters in the book.

They will continue to read a range of texts in Whole Class Guided Reading to develop their reading skills.

As writers, the children will be using the texts as stimulus to write for a variety of different purposes and audiences. This will include: descriptions and persuasion.

Mathematics

As mathematicians, the children will have focused lessons to consolidate their arithmetic skills. They will develop their knowledge and skills of decimals and percentages before moving on to learn at perimeter and area of shapes. The children will be using concrete resources and pictorial and abstract representations to extend their maths skills.



Computing

As computing citizens, children will be exploring search engines and how they work. They will also explore how to recognise reliable sources of information on the internet.

French

As linguists, the children will be continuing to learn language and vocabulary based on

'At the tea room'.



Science As scientists, the children will be learning about *Living Things* and their *Habitats*. Through this topic, they will learn the life cycles of mammals, birds, insects and amphibians from embryo to old age. They will also look at the life cycle of flowering and non-flowering plants, and how some plants can reproduce to create clones.

P.E

As athletes, the children will be learning the skills involved in the game of rounders. These will include throwing, catching, bowling, teamwork and co-operation. 5LK will be going swimming.

R.E

As thinkers, the children will be exploring the different religious buildings and their features. They will make connections between how believers feel about places of worship in different traditions.
