Don't forget to get planning; WBD is our first week back to school. The children can dress up as ANY character from a book, even better if they have the book to bring in and show their class!

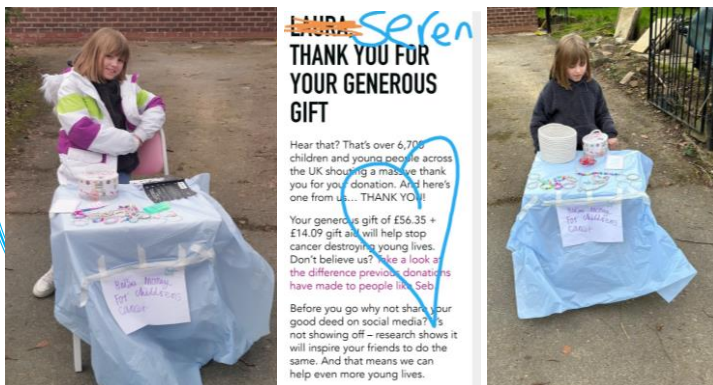
