# Welcome to the Broadstone Hall Primary School Newsletter! **HEADTEACHERS NOTE**

We trust that everyone is looking forward to the first of two Bank Holiday weekends this month.

As a Leadership Team we have noticed a steady pattern of children walking home alone from KS2 as the nights get lighter. Whilst we are happy to support this new independence, we would encourage the following protocol:

- 1. Please inform the Office via phone or email if your child is going to start walking home from school without an adult. This way, the class teacher and SLT on the gate can be aware of their movements.
- 2. This also applies to walking home after an afterschool
- 3. We are aware some children are meeting at the park after school rather than going straight home. Whilst this is not an immediate concern, we would suggest to all parents to download the Life 360 app which allows you to track the location of your child at all times.
- 4. All children must be reminded when wearing the school uniform; they must uphold the reputation of the school outside school premises.

# WHAT'S BEEN HAPPENING IN CLASS


