Music

As musicians, the children will be learning how to sing to the song Dancing in the Street, originally written by Marvin Gaye. They will explore rhythm and notation and composition.

Geography

As geographers, the children will be learning about their local area of Stockport. They will be developing the skills of place knowledge, map reading and analysis of data. They will also be completing some local fieldwork. They will also be exploring the time zones and biomes of the world.

Art

As artists, the children will be learning about colour theory by studying tints, shades and tones. They will study features of landscapes before using this knowledge to create landscape paintings.

As citizens, the children will be learning how to live in a World Without Judgement, exploring how to respect differences in others and maintain healthy friendships.



English

As readers, we have a range of books to enjoy. The children will be focusing firstly on the novel The Butterfly Lion, written by our class author Michael Morpurgo. The children will also explore a wide range of texts during our Whole Class Guided Reading sessions.

As writers, the children will be securing a range of sentence types in the context of our class novel, with a particular emphasis on grammar, punctuation, handwriting and spelling.

Mathematics

As mathematicians, the children will build on their knowledge of place value and addition and subtraction. They will work with numbers up to 1,000,000 and develop their arithmetic and reasoning skills. The children will be using concrete resources and pictorial and abstract representations to extend their maths skills. They will have weekly arithmetic sessions focusing on calculation and fluency.
