We will need a minimum 'quorum' of 8 non board members to attend so would be really grateful for your support. Everyone welcome including staff, parents, grandparents and carers.

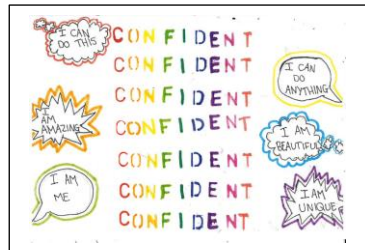
STOCKPORT MUSIC SERVICE IN SCHOOL

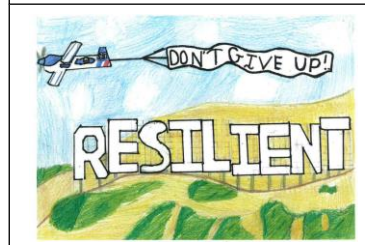
