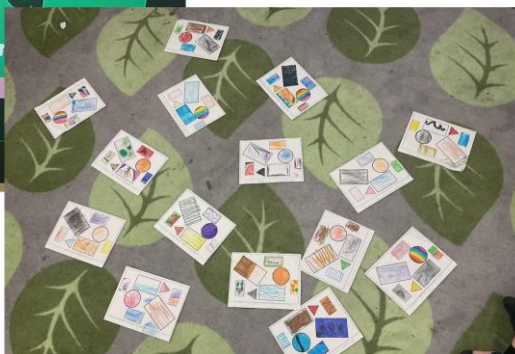


BLACK HISTORY MONTH

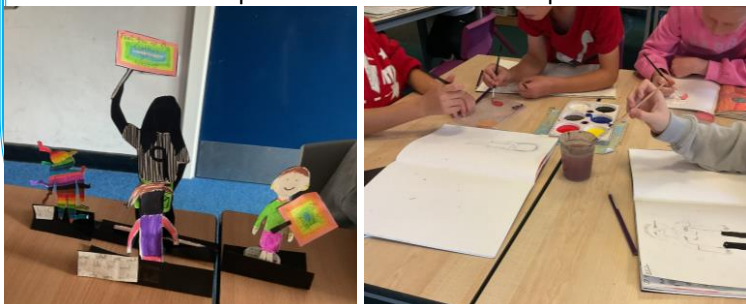


In **KS1** we created pictures inspired by **Lubaina Himid's** 'carpets' artwork.

After exploring 'The Tiger Who Came to Tea' book, Reception children were VERY excited to hold their own tea party this week – making their own decorations, cakes and invitations.



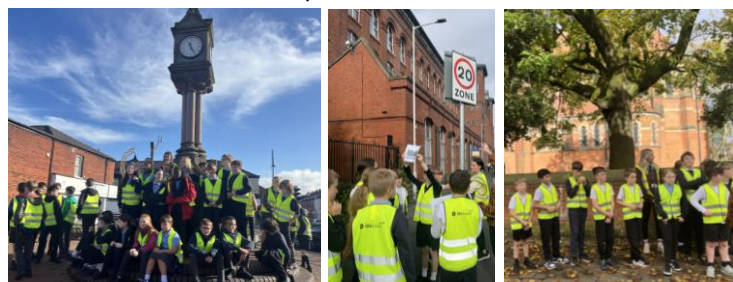
