HEADTEACHERS NOTE

We are aware that there will be lots of Halloween & Bonfire Night events going on this weekend and we would just like to draw your attention to the **Greater Manchester Fire & Rescue Service** "Bonfire and Halloween Campaign," in partnership with Greater Manchester Police and local councils.

This year's campaign will continue to focus on reducing anti-social behaviour (ASB) during the Halloween and bonfire period – including deliberate primary and secondary fires, attacks on emergency services, hoax calls and firework related ASB.

The Fire Service aim to reduce the number of firework & bonfire injuries by promoting firework and bonfire safety advice and encouraging residents to attend organised events if possible.
