NSPCC SPEAK OUT. STAY SAFE. PROGRAMME NSPCC

The NSPCC visited school at the end of last week (Y6) and this week (Y2 & Y5) to roll out their NSPCC's Speak out. Stay safe. Programme. Although an uncomfortable subject, it is one that needs addressing for all children and this child friendly programme for children aged 5-11 aims to help children understand abuse in all its forms and to recognise the signs of abuse. Children were taught to speak out if they are worried, either to a safe adult or Childline. The programme is aligned with the curriculum and consisted of age appropriate classroom based activities alongside a NSPCC volunteer. The content was delivered in an engaging and interactive way with the help of the NSPCC mascot Buddy.
