Music

As musicians, the children will be learning how to play the recorder. They will be reading and playing musical notations, as well as playing compositions as a duet, as a group and as a class.

Geography As geographers, the children will be using atlases and maps to locate the physical features in the region of California. They will explore the regions natural resources and how these are traded across the world. They will investigate the region's climate zones and vegetation belts. They will learn about the world's tectonic plates and the impact of natural disasters in California on the people who live there.



Art As artists, the children will be exploring how symbols and patterns can be used within artwork to communicate meaning. They will be exploring modern day examples such as graffiti and murals. The children will also be looking at symbolic artwork from the Maya period.

Mathematics

As mathematicians, the children will have focused lessons to develop their arithmetic skills. They will continue to develop their knowledge and skills in fractions and multiplication and division.

The children will be using concrete resources and pictorial and abstract representations to extend their maths skills.
