Reception Weekly News!

This week we have had three different visitors! We started our week with a visit from Ellis (Mr Taylors dog) who joined us on our weekly wander. The children had a question-and-answer session with Mr Taylor in the hall first, were they learned all about how Mr Taylor takes care of Ellis and what Ellis likes, before going on their weekly wander with him. Everyone got to have a turn helping to hold the lead and the children really enjoyed this experience! Our second visitor was Grace the vet. Grace taught us all about what vets do and how they look after poorly animals, she even demonstrated how they operate on a pet! Our final visitor was Helen the Lollypop lady, who taught us about road safety and how to cross the road safely. The children have demonstrated fantastic listening skills, shown great respect and asked some wonderful questions during our visitor sessions and it has been wonderful watching them delight in these experiences. Forest school group two got to make crowns in forest school, as well as explore the forest and had their first forest school fire. All children have been taught fire safety already and we all enjoyed watching it puff out white smoke when Mrs Whitlow used water to extinguish it! We have also been focusing on forming the letters I and t correctly. A formation sheet has been attached to the back of this sheet to help you support this learning at home. Remember to start at the top and go down! Letter formation can be done through play using shaving foam, flour or paint, as well as with a pencil and paper!

What have we been learning in Phonics?

At Broadstone Hall, we use the 'Monster Phonics' reading scheme to support our reading and writing. Our sound this week is

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Brown owl is the monster who colours the ow sound brown.

What have we been learning in Maths?

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This week we have been thinking about number composition. We have focused on number 5 and how it can be made. We have been using the stem sentence x is a part x is a part 5 is the whole e.g. 2 is a part 3 is a part 5 is the whole.
