Due to the current pandemic we have put in place a series of measures to keep all the children safe who will attend all of our summer courses. We will be implementing social distancing throughout the course. Please read the following information below before booking your child's place.

Bookings will be taken via the PSCL website (<https://primaryscl.coordinate.cloud/>).

There will be no cash payments on site.

All bookings will be in full week blocks (Monday – Friday) priced at £85 per week. Although you do not have to attend every day, you must book all week. This is to ensure the bubbles stay consistent and therefore safer for children and PSCL coaches.

Siblings attending together will receive a discount, please enter the code 'SIBLIN2020'

Places at the courses will be limited to 30 children. Children currently in reception – year 7 can attend the course

Children will have to book into a specific group 'bubble'. Each bubble will hold 15 places.

Bubble A – Key Stage 1 Multi Sports (reception – year 2)

Bubble B – Key Stage 2 Multi Sports (year 3 – year 7)

These are current year groups for the academic year 2019-2020. If your child has not started reception yet they will be unable to attend.

Bubble B – 8.45am
Collection times
Bubble A – 3.30pm
Bubble B - 3.45pm

We understand that occasionally children may have to arrive late and/or be collected early. So that we ensure parents / carers do not mix with others we ask that children who cannot be dropped off at their designated time do not arrive before 9.10am.

We ask that if a child needs to be collected early that they are collected before 3pm

Multi Sports

In line with current social distancing guidance we will not be playing any games and sports that involve physical contact. But don't worry, our experienced team have created a bank of games, challenges and loads of fun activities that will keep your children engaged and active.

Maths 'catch up'

Many children have missed weeks and months of school education. In addition to our sports and physical activities we will also give every child age appropriate active maths lessons with trained tutors.

PSCL Maths on the Move Tutor will deliver a socially distanced maths lessons with every child. As they are working across the bubbles the MOTM tutor will deliver lessons outside and from their own coaching zone. They will not be in direct contact with any child.
