## What have we been learning in Maths?

At Broadstone Hall, we follow the White Rose scheme. This week we have been practicing our careful counting. We have been remembering to put our objects in a line, count slowly and move each object after we have counted it. Can you practice this at home with your child?

## What have we been learning in phonics?

At Broadstone Hall, we use the 'Monster Phonics' reading scheme to support our reading and writing. These are the sounds we have learnt this week are:
